In the book <u>Low Country</u> Caroline Venable has everything her Southern heritage promised: money, prestige, a powerful husband—and a predictable routine of country-club luncheons, cocktail parties, and dinners hosting her husband's wealthy friends, clients, and associates in his successful land-developing conglomerate.

To escape her stifling routine, Caro drinks a little too much. But her true solace is the Lowcountry island her beloved Granddaddy left her—an oasis of breathtaking beauty that is home to a band of wild ponies. When Caro learns that her husband must develop the island or lose the business, she is devastated. The Lowcountry is her heritage—and what will happen to the ponies whose spirit and freedom have captivated her since childhood?

Saving the island could cost Caroline more than she ever imagined. To succeed, she must confront the part of herself numbed by alcohol and careful avoidance—and shatter long-held ideals about her role in society, her marriage, and ultimately, herself.



Our 3 Gifts



As our Mahomet United Methodist Church family participates this fall in the stewardship campaign *Our Three Gifts: A Program of Faithfulness* we have already begun to prepare for *Myrrh Sunday* on November 10 as you bring the food items that will be distributed through Helping Hands for

80 families in our area for Thanksgiving.

As you prepare for *Frankincense Sunday* on November 24 you are invited that Sunday to bring a representation of *Who Jesus is for Me*. You can draw, paint, or sculpt. You can make a collage, a banner, a quilt. You can bring in a picture that continues to encourage you each day. We are looking for a representation of the Jesus you serve in mission and ministry each day of your life so that with this artistically devotional display in the Welcome area our church family might draw together in the ways we reach out and invite others in.

On *Gold Sunday*, November 17, there will be a traditional pledge card campaign during worship with a catered lunch following the second service. Please register with the office for this welcoming time together around the table so that we can include our whole church family in fellowship as stewards and disciples of the one we follow each day.

September 2019 Finance Report

At our August meeting we continued to plan a Gold Sunday Celebration similar to our previous Consecration Sundays, to be held in November. If you would like to help, please contact Pastor Sweet or any member of the Finance Committee.

We also discussed the budget process for 2020 which will include a Narrative Budget making it easier to publish and share with the congregation. The other topic discussed was accounting services. Upon the retirement of Jan Gunthrie, we contacted five accounting firms for quotes. After reviewing their responses we hired YG Financial.

August unrestricted total income was \$ 23,104 for our church and total expenses were \$36,562 for a negative \$13,457 for the month. January through August 2019 unrestricted total income was \$256,471 and total expenses were \$283,375 for a negative \$26,904. Last year January through August 2018 unrestricted total income was \$241,202 and total expenses were \$284,374 for a negative \$43,171.

As always, we are a transparent organization. The reports are always available on request. We thrive as a church because of our congregation's generosity and faithfulness.


