Over the years as I've read and continued to learn and stretch myself, I've kept a collection of thoughts and sayings and quotes that have connected with me. Some have ended up in sermons. Some have been used in these kinds of monthly reflections. Some you've seen as thoughts for worship. While others I've just kept. The first one I wrote down on a 3x5 card during High School, and now my collection of quotes is 104pp with 1277 different quotes in a Word file. My first one though was from the book The Proper Study of Mankind by B. A. Howard. I'll tell you in a bit what it said, but first I want to share something else I've kept track of over the years.

Since 1976 when I preached my first sermon, and yes I did speak in church for a few years before that but this was the first time I was paid for what I was saying [and they were quite kind as I talked with them about Platonic Forms and the shape of reality] I will have by June 30th preached 1,684 Sermons in 48 different places and made 86 different talks and lectures. I have baptized 142 persons in age from a couple of hours old to 86 years old and welcomed into membership 115 confirmands. I have married 101 couples and buried 213 saints [and I imagine one or two sinners]. I have been in appointed ministry in 11 different communities and helped out in 3 others.

When I was ordained and admitted into probationary membership the Bishop asked me a question that I had been asked by the Board of Ministry and the District Superintendent and many other folks since then. What Bishop Choy asked was, "What do I want to do with my life?" And I said then, what I continue to say: "I want to be in ministry with the people of a local church." And I believe that by the grace of God, I have.

Oh, what that first quote I kept was that:

"The average person has in them: Enough water to fill a 10 gallon barrel; enough fat for 7 bars of soap; carbon for 9,000 lead pencils; phosphorus for 2,200 match-heads; iron for 1 medium sized nail; lime enough to whitewash a chicken coop; and small quantities of magnesium and sulfur.'

I've kept this because as I read it again, I am reminded of Psalm 90 [go ahead, look it up, read it and come back, I'll wait ... can you hear the theme from Jeopardy in your head ... I can]. Anyway, it has kept me focused on what is most important in my living: whose I am, not on what I am, or have.

Pick up will be at the Club in the parking lot, just pull in for no-contact pick up. Every youth under 18 is eligible, no paperwork, no restrictions, no questions. This is possible because of a summer meal program through the C-UPHD.
