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### **QUICK REVIEW**

3. What are the spiritual needs in our church? In our community and in our world? What resources do we have to meet those needs? Are you one of the resources?

1. Did you hear a connection between the gospel story and your story? Did you hear a connection between Janet's story and our Biblical lesson on resources?

2. Review the scripture and your sermon notes. Is there one thing that you want to work on this week? What would be steps that you need to take?
