From the Finance Committee,

For the month of April 2018, our Unrestricted Giving income was \$39,106 and our expenses were \$30,764. Year to date as of April 2018, our Unrestricted Giving income is \$125,297 and our expenses are \$138,531 leaving a -\$13,234 net. After we take in to account the 2018 pledges paid in 2017 and averaged for the year, it would essentially be a - \$1384 as of the end of April.

Thank you to the members and friends who have given to the special Easter offering. Half of the offering was donated to the Mahomet Area Youth Club which received \$1282.50. Human Relations, Native American Ministries, Peace with Justice, World Communion and the United Methodist Student Fund received \$256.50 apiece.

This month

Our beloved Sunday School teachers need a break from their weekly commitment, so for summer we are going to try this model...

Each Sunday starting June 17th a different family (or team of people) will take turns providing a lesson during the sermon of the 10:45am service. Kids will stay through the end of the children's message then they will be dismissed to the education wing where one family (or team of people) will provide a lesson.

We have a curriculum titled "INCREDIBLE FAITH". The team will be provided with materials to make the lesson meaningful, but are strongly encouraged to make it their own. The lessons are designed for incoming Kindergarteners through 5th graders, but we would love our Junior High and High School students to be included as helpers when their family leads a lesson. Children 0-4 years will be best suited in the nursery but if accompanied by an adult they are welcome to participate in the lesson too!
