INTERNET UPDATE

Trustees were able to upgrade our internet service through a grant that was gifted to us by our annual conference for school coop ministry support. Trustees and church council have approved for groups of students to be in classrooms during the day. Because of this ministry, our church is able to share from the blessings of God. A 4th grade coop meets here 5 days a week with parents taking turns proctoring the classroom. A teacher meets with these 4th graders via zoom and gives them instruction and classwork.

The high school ATLAS program meets here 4 days a week. This group is learning life lessons along with classroom learning. They are able to help us with small tasks like sorting and counting the school bag donations for UMW. They have a daily cleaning routine that aids in keeping our building sanitized. Send both of these groups a note of encouragement this month as part of your stewardship pledge, to do no harm, do good and love God and neighbor.

Because of the upgraded internet, we have one more room designated for Jr High and High school students from our congregation. This is a quiet room for up to four students at a time to use our internet for classroom instruction and homework, especially if a family's internet is not reliable. Call the church office to let us know you need to reserve a space in this room.

The upgraded internet also allows us to stream our Sunday morning worship service. People will be able to worship with us live on Sunday morning at 9:30 a.m. We welcome people to join us at the church or in their homes. In order to continue this ministry or reaching people for Jesus, we need 3 volunteers each week to run the computers and camera. If you can volunteer, please sign up on the website signup.com.

The upgraded system will also mean our phones will be upgraded. This will happen in the next few weeks. Messages are checked every day. If you need to reach Rev.
