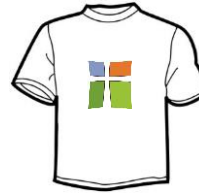

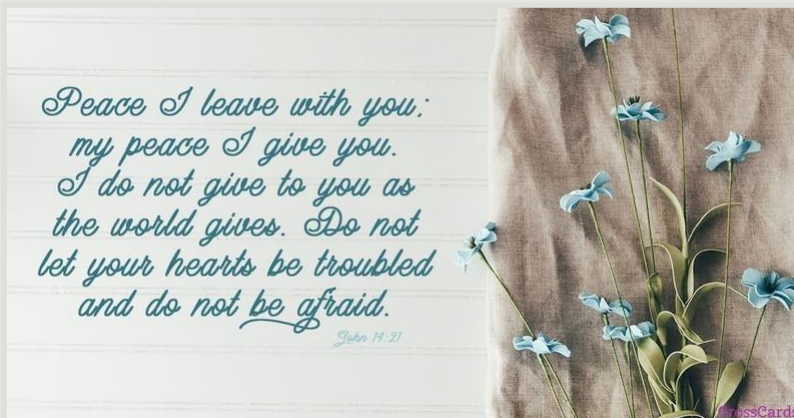
THURSDAY READING GROUP

FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT

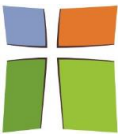
Dear Friends,

Pledged giving for the month of April was approximately \$44,000 and non-pledged giving was approximately \$7,000 making total giving about \$51,000. Total operating expenses were approximately \$29,000 making income for the month \$22,000. For the first 4 months of 2021 pledged giving was \$117,000 and non-pledged giving about \$28,000 making expenses of about \$107,000 through April 30.

The Finance Committee thanks the congregation for their generous support of our church's mission. It is so positive to have in person church again. Hosanna in the highest!

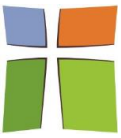
