MUMC SHIRTS AVAILABLE TO ORDER


It's time for a wardrobe update! You need something new and relevant in your closet. And what could be better than a MUMC polo or t-shirt?!

FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT

Dear Friends,

Pledged giving for the month of June was approximately \$19,000 and non-pledged giving was approximately \$4,000 making total giving about \$23,000. Total operating expenses were approximately \$29,000 generating a net loss for the month of \$6,000. For the first 6 months of 2021 pledged giving was \$181,000 and non-pledged giving about \$35,000 making total income about \$216,000 versus expenses of about \$172,000 through June 30.

The Finance Committee thanks the congregation for their generous support. Thank you for supporting our church ministries!


