

Prayer through meditation on God's voice





THURSDAY READING CIRCLE

MAY: Once Upon a Town by Bob Greene



In search of "the best America there ever was," bestselling author and award-winning journalist Bob Greene finds it in a small Nebraska town few

people pass through today – a town where Greene discovers the echoes of the most touching love story imaginable: a love story between a country and its sons.

During World War II, American soldiers from every city and walk of life rolled through North Platte, Nebraska, on troop trains en route to their ultimate destinations in Europe and the Pacific. The tiny town, wanting to offer the servicemen warmth and support transformed its modest railroad depot int the the North Platte Canteen.

Every day of the year, every day of the war, the Canteen – staffed and funded entirely by local volunteers – was open from five am until the last troop train of the day pulled away after midnight. Astonishingly, the remote plains community of only 12,000 people provided welcoming words, friendship, and baskets of food and treats to more than six million GIs by the time the war ended.

In this poignant and heartwarming eyewitness history, based on interviews with North Platte residents and the soldiers who once passed through Bob Greene tells a classic, lost-in-the-mists-of-time American story of a grateful country honoring its brave and dedicated sons.



<u>Update from the Trustees Committee and Parsonage Subcommittees</u>

Trustees approved the first phase of the NatureScape playground addition on the north side of our church. The addition includes a pea-gravel digging pit with equipment for youngsters who enjoy playing with construction equipment in the outdoors and a gaga ball pit for older youth. If you are not familiar with gaga ball, I encourage you to view a YouTube video on the subject. A contract for installation was awarded to Sunset Landscaping for \$2,500 and was paid for by donor funds. Stacy Schroeder has been heading the project and has been working with Justin Lamb from Sunset. We hope to have the features complete for use this summer.

Installation of a new water bottle filler/drinking fountain in the hallway outside of the restroom area is scheduled for this week. It was paid for by donor funds from the Schroeder Family. The parsonage subcommittee and the trustees committee unanimously approved a motion to request a Charge Conference to allow for a vote on construction of a parsonage. It was decided to convene the meeting as a Church Conference, allowing all members in attendance to vote, rather than just Church Council members. Church members at the Church Conference, presided over by District Superintendent Rev. Angie Lee, passed the following motion by a vote of 38 for and 21 against: "The congregation of the Mahomet United Methodist Church authorizes the Trustees to contract for the purpose of construction of a parsonage for an estimated cost of \$420,000 plus miscellaneous related items of approximately \$20,000". The next step in the process is the awarding of a contract for construction to begin. There is a need for a small design committee to make choices for materials and finishes within the approved budget. Finance Committee Report

Dear Friends,

Pledged giving for the month of March was approximately \$14,000 and non-pledged giving was approximately \$2,000 making total unrestricted giving about \$15,000. \$12,100 in Employer Tax Credits from 2021 were also received bringing total unrestricted income to about \$28,000. Total operating expenses were approximately \$29,000 generating a net operating loss for the month of \$1,000. Year to date pledged giving is about \$81,000, non-pledged about \$6,000 and other income about \$25,000 for a total of \$112,000 in unrestricted revenue. Year to date unrestricted expenses total about \$89,000 making net income for the year about \$23,000.






