



Update from the Trustees Submitted by G. Kling June 28, 2022

Update on the Parsonage

Contract documents with Nelson Builders have been updated to reflect the modifications requested by the trustees. At this time, we are not anticipating adding a bathroom, bedroom or recreation room to the basement due to the cost. The basement will have utilities for a future bathroom stubbed in and the basement will also have 2 egress windows included so that a bedroom could be added in the future. The floorplan will expand slightly through the addition of 3' extension to the dining area to make it more functional. We are currently in the quite phase of construction. Materials such as doors, windows, plumbing fixtures, lumber, etc. have been ordered and will take varying amounts of time to arrive. The home being constructed will be Energy Star Certified to save on utility bills. Other Updates:

Our thanks goes out to Keaton Roberts who is power washing the church siding to remove algae and dirt. If you are willing to help in this effort, please contact Gary Kling at 217 493-0212.

There will likely be construction on South Mahomet Road this summer that will for a period, cut off access from the south, and at times, narrow our entrance driveway. We look forward to the completion of the project and hope to gain from the visibility the increased traffic will bring.

The bankruptcy settlement of the Boy Scouts of America appears to be slowly making its way through the courts. Even as those details are being worked out, there are changes already underway. All BSA troops will need to sign a standardized affiliation agreement with their sponsoring organization (MUMC) over the next few months. The BSA has secured new liability insurance to protect them and the sponsoring organizations. This coverage will become effective July 1. The Trustees have reaffirmed their desire to have MUMC continue to sponsor BSA Troop 25. The new affiliation agreements will require Troop 25 to reassign their assets to the local BSA council which will hold them for the local troops. Those assets include the scout trailer and cash reserves. The full details of the new affiliation agreements are not yet known.

Finance Committee Report

Dear Friends,

Pledged giving for the month of May was approximately \$17,000 and non-pledged giving was approximately \$2,000 making total unrestricted giving about \$19,000. Total operating expenses were approximately \$34,000 generating a net operating loss for the month of \$15,000. Year to date operating income was about \$150,000 (\$114K pledged giving, \$11K non-pledged giving and \$25K from employer tax credits) versus expenses of \$156,000.

Church expenses have been exceeding giving so far this summer, so please continue to fund your pledged giving regularly. If you have not made a payment this year, it would be a good time to begin as we need your support.

Mahomet and Seymour residents are blessed to have a source of free food if they are in need.

At this time, Eileen Waters, the MUMC coordinator who works with Helping Hands, is particularly wanting to find elderly people in need of food.

Food costs are rapidly going up, making it difficult for those with limited income to buy all that they need.

Helping Hands, an organization established in 1983, offers help to all residents of Mahomet and Seymour the 3rd Saturday of each month from 9 to 11 at their 203 E. Adams location.


