

Trustee Committee Report- Update August 22

The last few weeks have been quite eventful, with activity on our HVAC (heating ventilation and cooling) and fire suppression systems. The provider for our HVAC services, P&P Heating and Cooling, went out of business this spring. Their closure did not allow for them to complete our air conditioning preventative maintenance plans. Their business has been purchased by a company called 217, Inc. The 217, Inc. representatives indicated that they would honor our preventative AC maintenance contract, and within the week began to service our units. They found a hole in the heat exchanger in one of the two large furnaces that heat our sanctuary, and major leaks in two of our 11 AC units (one in the south education wing, and one in the Wesley Prayer Room). The Trustees will make decisions on repair vs replacements at our meeting Thursday, August 25.

The fire-suppression piping developed a leak this past week that required the replacement of a section of a large 3" diameter pipe. We are grateful to Lance Noone who oversaw the repairs to keep our fire suppression system functioning.

I finally have some updates on the parsonage construction to share with you. The following is an estimate of what will occur, given cooperation of weather and supply issues.

Finance Committee Report

Dear Friends,

Pledged giving for the month of July was approximately \$34,000 and non-pledged giving was approximately \$2,000 making total unrestricted giving about \$36,000. Total operating expenses were approximately \$34,000 generating a net operating profit for the month of \$2,000. Year-to-date operating income was about \$221,000 (\$180K pledged giving, \$16K non-pledged giving and \$25K from employer tax credits) versus expenses of \$223,000.

The parsonage construction process is scheduled to begin in September. It is too early to predict a firm completion date.






