





Trustee Committee Report-February 17, update

The end of January and early February has been a relatively quiet time for the trustees. Due to a lack of items requiring decisions, the February meeting was cancelled and the few items needing attention will be voted upon online. Fortunately, we did not experience any major equipment failures over the last few weeks.

The parsonage progress continues with the tiling in the master bathroom nearly complete. There was an additional delay for the kitchen cabinets, and they are now expected to arrive Monday Feb. 20. Nelson Builders still plans for an early March completion of the house. Grading work and lawn seeding will have to wait until spring.

We hope to have final plans and a construction schedule for the ADA pathway from the parking lot to the pavilion in the next few weeks.

Finance Committee Report

Pledged giving for the month of January was approximately \$51,000 and non-pledged giving was approximately \$3,000 making total unrestricted income about \$54,000. Total operating expenses were approximately \$33,000 generating net operating income for the month of \$21,000. The church also applied for (well done Pastor Lori and Gary Kling) and received a grant for \$25,000 from the Fellheimer Trust to offset a portion of the 2022 HVAC expenses. We are off to a good start in 2023. Thank you for supporting our church ministries! Financial reports are always available upon request.




