



Trustee Committee Report-

The parsonage is nearing completion, with installation of carpeting, lighting and plumbing fixtures to occur within the week and tiling of one shower remaining. Rev. Lori and David are planning to move-in on Wednesday March 29. Installation of blinds from Flooring Surfaces will occur after move-in. Two Men and a Truck will be moving the larger furniture and volunteers will help with the rest. Completion of outdoor work will await favorable spring weather.

Excavation and pouring of concrete for an ADA path from the parking lot to the Pavilion is awaiting for the ground to firm up following spring rains.

Contracts with Parklawn Services, Inc. and Terminix Inc. were approved at the March 16 meeting. Our kitchen freezer required another repair to keep it operating. Trustees are looking for a temperature alarm system to prevent further losses of food when the unit breaks down.

Finance Committee Report

Pledged giving for the month of February was approximately \$26,000 and non-pledged giving was approximately \$4,000 making total unrestricted income about \$30,000. Total operating expenses were approximately \$42,000 generating net operating loss for the month of \$12,000. The expenses for February included \$11,000 for a HVAC unit installed in December. Year to date unrestricted income is about \$85,000 (\$77K pledged and \$8K non-pledged) versus expenses of approximately \$75,000. A gift for over \$10,000 was received for the parsonage.

Thank you for supporting our church ministries! Financial reports are always available upon request.

Education/Discipleship Committee

Easter Sunday is on April 9th. In between our two services at 9:00 service and 10:30 service, we will have an Easter Egg Hunt! Our thanks to the congregation for their donations of candy and prizes! Volunteers are lined up to stuff the candy or prize tickets into our plastic eggs and to hide them Easter morning. We could still use a few volunteers to oversee the Egg Hunt and Prize Table immediately after the Hunt.

We are waiting to meet the new MAYC director and set up event scheduling with her. The committee still wants to provide six to eight one-time events for the MAYC students, but we do not yet know the Director's ideas for the summer program. If anyone in the congregation would enjoy coordinating a one-time event for MAYC, please let Joan Kling or Michelle Petty know! If possible, we would like to have a relative idea of events to present to the MAYC director so it can be placed on their calendar right from the beginning.

This summer we are planning on using a food truck theme for Vacation Bible School called Food Truck Party: On a Roll with God. We are more than happy to have tentatively planned a more traditional VBS- a four day long morning VBS from June 26th through June 30th. (Monday through Thursday). Please get it on your home calendar!

Please look for ways to help as we try to restore this summer tradition! We are searching for volunteers to help with escorting groups to their activities, someone to help organize snacks in the kitchen, a recreation leader, registration table help to check in the children as they arrive, and tech help at the beginning and end of the program!

APRIL 13, 1:30 pm: Have You Seen Luis Velez? By Catherine Hyde (322 pages)

New York Times bestselling author Catherine Ryan Hyde brings heartwarming authenticity to the story of two strangers who find that kindness is a powerful antidote to fear.

Raymond Jaffe feels like the doesn't belong. Not with his mother's new family. Not as a weekend guest with his father and his father's wife. Not at school where he is an outcast. After his best friend moves away, Raymond has only two real connections: to the feral cat he has tamed and to a blind nine-ty-two year old woman in his building who's introduced herself with a curious question: "Have you seen Luis Velez?"

Mildred Gutermann, a German Jew who narrowly escaped the Holocaust, has been alone since her caretaker disappeared. She turns to Raymond for help, and as he tries to track Luis down, a deep and unexpected friendship blossoms between the two.

Despondent at the loss of Luis, Mildred isolates herself further from the neighborhood devolving into bigotry and fear. Determined not to let her give up, Raymond helps her see that for every terrible act the world delivers, there is a mirror image of deep kindness, and Mildred helps Raymond see that there's hope if you have someone to hold on to.




