#### The series will kick off on June 4. Please come and get a sweet gift!




Summer Time has arrived for WOW, Come Play with Me and Toddler Time. They are taking summer off but back again in September!


Our very own Joyce & John Schmale won Top Car! Woohoo!

#### **Trustee Committee Report**

With the completion of the new sidewalk from the parking lot to the pavilion, Rob Parker provided the seeding, and trustees are watering the new bright green grass along the edges of the new sidewalk. Numerous groups have already found the sidewalk to be very helpful. The parsonage is inching its way towards completion, with the checklist of things to finish being gradually whittled down. Repair of concrete work still remains. Also on the outside, rough grading has been completed and underground downspout drains are being installed by Doug Lape. Additional rainfall would be helpful to accelerate the ground settling around the foundation. Following final grading, the front and sides will be sodded, and the back yard seeded with grass. New temperature monitors to keep track of refrigerator and freezer problems, were installed by Scott Yeazel The sensors send out on-line warnings to a list of recipients. Two new computers for the office were purchased with memorial funds and several other older machines are being ugraded as appropriate. An expansion of our playground is in the works this summer with the addition of a play structure for smaller children and a sitting area for adults. It is being funded by the Thelma Labhart memorial gift. Our fire suppression system continues to require frequent repair. One of the two small compressors that are part of the nitrogen-based fire suppression system has failed and we are seeking answers on our leak problems before spending on another compressor. An outside vendor is being brought in to help troubleshoot the system.

#### **Finance Committee Report**

Pledged giving for the month of April was approximately \$18,000 and non-pledged giving was approximately \$10,000 making total unrestricted income about \$28,000. Total operating expenses were approximately \$31,000 generating net operating loss for the month of \$4,000. The Easter offering was \$1,605. Year to date unrestricted income is about \$136,000 (\$115K pledged and \$21K non-pledged) versus expenses of approximately \$141,000. Thank you for supporting our church ministries! Financial reports are always available upon request.

#### **Education/Discipleship Committee**

The Education Discipleship Committee has been working on the upcoming VBS program! The Food Truck Party: On a Roll with God will take place the last week of June, so it's coming up quickly! We still need a Recreation leader, two more group guides, and some singers and dancers for the openings and closings. Finally, another training is set on Sunday, June 4 from 11:30-12:30. Training is required for anyone planning on working with Children in VBS, MAYC, or any of our other regularly scheduled children's programs that has NOT done the training in the last 3 years. Background checks still need to be performed every year. If you plan on helping please stop by the office and fill our a form that Michelle will have. Trained members will need to refresh their training every two or three years, not every year. Any new church volunteers for MAYC or VBS need to make sure they get the training, especially before the week of VBS. The Education/Discipleship Committee has committed to two events with MAYC. One is a ice cream social or sundae bar and Bingo, possibly with the Spicy Seniors, or other members of the congregation. Unfortunately, we will not be offering Children's Church this summer. Since we have had significant difficulty finding volunteers, we had been looking for someone who would take this on as a summer paid position. We were unable to fill this position so Children's Church will be taking a break over the summer. In the fall we plan to offer a grief support group to be led by Laurel as our lay leader. The book to be used is called Grief Work. We are noting that we will be dealing with the topic of loss (death, divorce, addiction, etc.) in a supportive, group setting. We need to begin to organize to advertise this class. Thoughts include advertise to local therapists, area pastors, and social media. The journaling books we have are copies that can be sent to grieving families when appropriate. Kris will write a general letter concerning the availability of these books as a resource.
