

### Trustee Committee Report

In the past week, we saw significant efforts from the contractor to finish up the parsonage. A variety of small interior issues were resolved, with only one small item remaining in the interior. A subcontractor delivered and laid the sod for the front and side lawns this week. Due to the late timing for installing sod, the contractor has agreed to pay for the water charges this summer. Village of Mahomet service technicians installed outdoor supplementary water meters to eliminate sewage charges for our water usage. The back yard will be seeded in fall when we can establish a lawn without excessive water usage. If you haven't seen it yet, you should come and check out the latest addition to our children's playground behind the church. The new equipment includes a play and climbing structure and slide suitable for younger children along with a two-person glider suitable for youth and adults. There will also be a picnic table installed as part of the project in a few weeks. This addition was provided for by Thelma Labhart memorial funds. We are in the process of seeking and evaluating bids for our church's property and liability insurance to better protect the church with the potential addition of the fall and spring afterschool program for K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade by the not-for-profit, Brianna's Buddies. Groups like MACY and the afterschool children's programs are required to have insurance that meets our standards; however, we seek an additional level of protection for the church. We will soon see the addition of another new furnace/AC combination to provide climate control for rooms 308, 310 and 312. The AC unit that cooled that area developed a large leak, and it would have required over two thousand dollars for the refrigerant alone for that old unit. Lanz Inc. submitted the successful bid for a high efficiency AC and furnace. This replacement will leave us with only 3 of the original 11 heating and cooling systems remaining. The nitrogen generator on our fire protection system continues to give us problems. The manufacturer has agreed to provide some replacement components free of charge.

### Finance Committee Report

Pledged giving for the month of May was approximately \$20,000 and non-pledged giving was approximately \$6,000 making total unrestricted income about \$26,000. Total operating expenses were approximately \$38,000 generating net operating loss for the month of \$12,000. The expenses for May included \$5,278 for annual property insurance. Year to date unrestricted income is about \$162,000 (\$135K pledged and \$27K non-pledged) versus expenses of approximately \$180,000.There were a number of memorial fund expenditures during the month for a sidewalk, new playground equipment and blinds. Thank you for supporting our church ministries!

### Education/Discipleship Committee

MAYC has began their third week in the building. Outreach events are planned with MAYC's students, see Michelle for details. Vacation Bible School currently is in full swing this week with an enrollment of about 35 kids. We have over twenty volunteers from the church, and not only have they volunteered their time, but they have also volunteered supplies and money. On behalf of the office staff and everyone at the church, we want to give a huge shout out and Thank You to all the volunteers and everyone who has participated and helped us pull all this together. This fall Michelle will be teaching Women's Bible Study. This summer Michelle will be leading the study of Amos beginning on July 11th for eight weeks. Pastor Lori and Tony Early will be teaching Disciple Bible Study– Prophets in the fall and Letters in the spring. The Healing Hearts Ministry, formerly known as Grief Share, continues their work with workshops scheduled monthly. A Support Group Class will begin Saturday, September 16th and run through Saturday, November 4th. There will be Journaling Books available to be given to grieving families as needed.


