




Trustee

- ~Trustees are currently evaluating insurance quotes from two companies, & possibly a third.
- ~Our newest air conditioner and furnace combo has been installed & is providing cooling for Rooms 306, 308, 310 & 312.
- ~Parts for the repair of our nitrogen generator on our fire suppression system have begun arriving and their installation is expected in early August.
- ~Ethan Kempher is in the planning stages for his Eagle Scout Project which will include adding more bleacher space to our ballfield & repair of the existing bleachers.
- "Melvin Bell has been making repairs to the train on the playground and applying a preservative stain.
- ~Large rubber mats are being purchased to place under the playground swings to increase the safety due the heavy use that area is receiving which results in movement of the protective mulch out from under the swings.
- ~Several other projects are in the bidding stage, including repair/replacement of non-functioning parking lot lights, sealing and repainting of our parking lot asphalt.
- ~Church staff & trustees are currently working with Second St. Painting whom is providing some painting for free. The first location to be painted is the area behind the altar to improve the background for our on-line streaming.




