



Trustees Committee Updates

- Parts for our nitrogen generator and fire control system have arrived and we are awaiting installation of a new compressor and some air handling valves by Matco Fire Protection Inc.
- The next step in the completion of our parsonage is the seeding of turfgrass in the back yard and addition of landscape plants. The sod has taken root and looks great. Most minor construction issues with the contractor have been resolved.
- We needed to change our property and liability insurance, as Country Financial would not provide liability insurance for the after-school programs. State Farm declined coverage for the program & Church Mutual declined to bid due to our recent hail & water damage claims. We picked up coverage with Philadelphia Insurance Companies through Snyder Insurance of Champaign.
- A **BIG** Thank You to Laurel Matthews, Doug Beckman, & Scott Yeazel in helping us through the reinsurance process.
- Beginning August 16, 2023, weekdays from 12:00pm to 6:00pm the trustees have approved a temporary ban on all firearms being on church property, as required by DCFS in order for us to host the afterschool children's program. The ban will be lifted after May 21, 2024.
- Thanks to the work of Craig Kempher, the Village of Mahomet is supplying between 4-8 trees to replace the 4 trees that were removed during the widening of South Mahomet Road & installation of the bike path.
 - The Trustee's are planning for the repair if several malfunctioning parking lot lights and the resealing of our asphalt parking lot.
