





TRUSTEES COMMITTEE

The nitrogen generation system received some updates in the past week, with a new compressor and air-handling valves. It is currently functioning again.

The sod around the front and sides of the parsonage is now well-established and looking good, while the back lawn was recently seeded by Rob Parker and is beginning to turn green.

The Village of Mahomet will be providing us with 8 new trees to replace the four trees we lost to construction of the bike path. The new trees will be planted around the south side of the ball field.

The asphalt parking lot is scheduled for resealing and new lines painted during the last week of September at a cost of \$10,000. The asphalt on the upper one-third of the parking lot is beginning to fail and will need to be repaved in the next year at a cost of \$40,000 - \$50,000. Failure to repave soon will result in the need to fully remove and repave at an even higher cost.

The concrete approaching 3 of the 4 north-side doors is beginning to fail and is scheduled to be replaced yet this fall by Bill Slade of Colonial LLC Concrete at a cost of \$4,000.

Being Sheela; The Life Journey of an Immigration Lawyer, by Aditi Rao

Sheela Murthy—Immigration lawyer, entrepreneur and philanthropist —has helped many people overcome injustice, dispossession and legal tangles, so they may live a life of dignity in an increasingly challenging world. With insightful detours into her eventful growing-up years, the book follows Sheela's journey from India to America, through law school at Harvard to the inception of what went on to become one of the most successful immigration law firms in the world — the Murphy Law Firm. The book takes a close look at a few out of the countless cases that Sheela and her dynamic legal team have handled over twenty-five years. Being Sheela is about the human side of a successful professional, and immigrant and a woman of color, who has made it her purpose to strive for a better world.

A Light in the Forest by Melissa Payne

Vega Jones escapes an abusive relationship with nothing but her two-month-old baby and the van she grew up in. Her destination is a small Ohio town her late vagabond mother left years ago. It's full of nobodies, her mom warned. That makes it the ideal refuge for Vega to lie low, feel safe, and maybe learn more about a past her mother never spoke of.

Vega warms to the town and to new acquaintances like Heff, the young deputy and artist who prefers his yard art to actual policing, and empathetic Eve, a local farmer whose near-death experience gave her more than just her life back. But even in this welcoming community, there's an undercurrent of something unsettled, talk of tragedy that unfolded in the woods years ago, and a mystery connected to Vega in ways she couldn't have anticipated.
