



-SEPTEMBER FINANCIAL REPORT-

- Church maintenance is \$27,000 over budget (HVAC replacement represents \$18,000 of this overage)
- Insurance is \$6,000 higher to properly cover the children's programs.

TRUSTEES COMMITTEE

- Ethan Kempher has nearly completed all parts of his Eagle Scout Project at our ball field. His project included fixing the old bleachers, adding a new set of bleachers on a new concrete pad behind home plate and putting up a sign to inform users that the ball field is provided by the Mahomet United Methodist Church. The project was completely funded by the Scouts and ball teams.
- Eight trees (provided by the Village of Mahomet for replacing what they removed for construction of the bike path) were acquired by Craig Kempher & planted outside of the ball field by Scout Troop 25; directed by Craig Kempher & Rob Parker.
- Most of the burned-out light bulbs in the sanctuary pendant light fixtures were replaced by Kevin Williams. There are a couple of fixtures that will require repair by an electrician.
- Our parking lot was recently resealed, buying us some time to determine how to pay for an asphalt overlay of our entire parking lot. We have a number of areas where cracks were too large to refill when the lot was resealed and several large areas where the asphalt is failing. The cost of the overlay will exceed \$100,000.
- A snow removal contract with Main Street Landscaping Co. was approved for the winter of 2023-2024.
- A preventative maintenance contract for upkeep of our furnaces and air conditioners over the next year from ____217, Inc. was approved.

EDUCATION

Planning is already underway for our church Christmas celebration. Two Advent studies will be available. Children's activities, as well as activities for the whole family, are being developed to celebrate this holy season.

Vega Jones escapes an abusive relationship with nothing but her two-month-old baby and the van she grew up in. Her destination is a small Ohio town her late vagabond mother left years ago. It's full of nobodies, her mom warned. That makes it the ideal refuge for Vega to lie low, feel safe, and maybe learn more about a past her mother never spoke of.

Vega warms to the town and to new acquaintances like Heff, the young deputy and artist who prefers his yard art to actual policing, and empathetic Eve, a local farmer whose near-death experience gave her more than just her life back. But even in this welcoming community, there's an undercurrent of something unsettled, talk of tragedy that unfolded in the woods years ago, and a mystery connected to Vega in ways she couldn't have anticipated.
