

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Update from Church Council

Discussions are continuing on how to best pay for the substantial maintenance costs that we face. Some of these needs we can anticipate, such as replacement of aging HVAC systems and repaving of the parking lot; whereas others, such as leaking gas lines or fire system breaks, are more difficult to predict. Even with insurance coverage, there are always related costs that are not fully paid by insurance, as well as items that are not covered, such as our recent gas line replacement. Given the magnitude of our needs, it becomes clear that our maintenance expenditures will exceed what our normal budget can accommodate in the next few years. Although we will try to take advantage of grants, those are not likely to pay for a very large portion of our costs. One solution currently being discussed in Church Council is a special fund drive for maintenance. Another possible source of revenue for the Church is the addition of new members to our congregation. Council members have been tasked with suggesting ways to increase our membership. Those ideas are being debated in Council and we hope to implement the best of those ideas. We welcome any input from the congregation that will help to increase membership.

TRUSTEES REPORT

Trustees have obtained bids from Servpro and Blue Sky to repair and finish out damaged areas from the January water damage. We are in the process of analyzing the bids and working with the insurance adjustor to determine who we should contract with to make the restoration repairs. On January 31, an outside natural gas line leak was discovered. As a result, the underground gas line had to be replaced to bring the pipeline up to code. The replacement was finished on February 2. The cabinets for the conference room have been purchased and installed. For his Eagle Scout project, Jacob Heaton is cleaning the storage shed and building shelving.

EDUCATION

The Lenten theme for this year is "Dinner with Jesus", as we come together with others at the table in fellowship. We will be hosting Taco Tuesday on March 5th & 12th.

We will be having the Easter Egg Hunt again this year on Easter Sunday, March 31st, between services. Last year the congregation was very generous and enjoyed fellowship with each other while stuffing the eggs with candy provided by the congregation. We are asking for volunteers again this year to help stuff eggs and to bring in a bag of candy that can fit into the eggs.

Additionally, we are asking the Jr/Sr high students to help with the hiding of the eggs before and during first service. Will need volunteers to man the prize table.

When Josie Jensen, an awkward 13-year-old musical prodigy, crashes headlong into newcomer Samuel Yates, 18-year-old Navajo boy full of anger and confusion, an unlikely friendship, and along the way finds a kindred spirit. Upon graduation, Samuel abandons the sleepy, small town in search of a future and a life, leaving his young friend behind. Many years go by and Samuel returns, finding Josie in need of the very thing she offered him years before. Their roles reversed, Samuel teaches Josie about life, love, and letting go.

Deeply romantic and poignant, Running Barefoot is the story of a small town girl and a Native American boy, the ties that bind them to their homes and families, and the love that gives them wings.

APRIL: The Hate U Give by Angie Thomas

Sixteen-year-old Starr Carter moves between two worlds: the poor neighborhood where she lives and the fancy prep school she attends. The uneasy balance between these worlds is shattered when Starr witnesses the fatal shooting of her childhood best friend Khalil at the hands of a police officer. Khalil was unarmed.

Soon afterward his death is a national headline. Some are calling him a thug, maybe even a drug dealer and a gang banger. Protesters are taking to the streets in Khalil's name. Some cops and local a drug lord try to intimidate Starr and her family. What everyone wants to know is what really went down that night? And the only one alive who can answer that is Starr.

But what Starr does – or does not say could upend hr community. It could also endanger her life.
