## FINANCIAL REPORT

NET OPERATING INCOME	- \$23,000
Operating Expenses	\$41,000
UNRESTRICTED INCOME	\$17,500
Non-Pledged	\$4,000
Pledged	\$13,500

- YTD income \$135,000 vs. unrestricted expenses of \$196,000 = <u>deficit of \$60,000</u>.
- Building related expenses are about \$32K over budget YTD. Unrestricted giving is about \$35K under budget for the year.
- Repairs related to the water leak continue. Insurance recoveries will cover nearly all of the projected costs.


