

TRUSTEES REPORT

- The Philadelphia Insurance claim from the water damage has been paid and closed.
- The fire suppression system is holding pressure and operating as it should, utilizing the nitrogen generator.
- S & K will be replacing the missing shingles on the roof. The roof is still under warranty.
- The original HVAC unit for the Narthex was not cooling properly and has been repaired but may need to be replaced in the coming year.

- YTD income \$273,000 vs. unrestricted expenses of \$326,000 = (about \$53,000 over budget) generating a \$65,000 operating loss for the year to date.
- The overage in expenses is due to church building and grounds maintenance costs being well over budget (+\$70K)

OCTOBER: THE WOMEN, A NOVEL by Kristen Hannah

From the celebrated author of The Nightingale and The Four Winds comes Kristen Hannah's The Women- at once an intimate portrait of coming of age in a dangerous time and an epic tale of a nation divided.

Women can be heroes. When twenty-yea-old nursing student Francis "Frankie" McGrath hears these words, it is a revelation. Raised in the sundrenched, idyllic world of Southern California and sheltered by her conservative parents, she has always prided herself on doing the right thing. But in 1965 the world is changing, and she suddenly dares to imagine a different future for herself. When her brother ships out to serve in Vietnam she joins the Army Nurse Corps and follows his path.

As green and inexperienced as the men sent o Vietnam to fight, Frankie is overwhelmed by the chaos and destruction of war. Each day is a gamble of life and death, hope and betrayal, friendships run deep and can be shattered in an instant.

In war she meets and becomes one of — the lucky, the broken, and the lost. But war is just the beginning for Frankie and her veteran friends. The real battle lies in coming home to a changed and divided America, to angry protesters, and to a country that wants to forget Vietnam.


