NET OPERATING BREAK EVEN—\$0

- YTD income \$296,000 vs. unrestricted expenses of \$350,000 = <u>generating a</u> <u>\$54,000 operating loss for the year to date</u>.
- The overage in expenses is due to church building and grounds maintenance costs being well over budget (+\$66K)
- Positive note a \$30K grant was received from the Fellheimner Foundation which is earmarked for the fire suppression system
