

FINANCIAL REPORT

Pledged \$26,000

Non-Pledged \$ 7,000 (\$1,700 Easter Offerings)

UNRESTRICTED INCOME \$33,000

NET OPERATING \$2,600 LOSS

- YTD unrestricted revenue through the end of April was about \$146,000 (\$121K pledged and \$25K non-pledged) versus unrestricted expenses of \$129K.
- The 2 new HVAC units were installed during April and cost about \$31,000. \$26,000 of this cost was paid from the accumulated balance in the building repair restricted account with the remainder being charged to the operating budget. This left a little over \$34,000 remaining in the building repair fund. \$30K of this remaining balance is a grant restricted for the fire suppression system and \$3K is restricted to window repairs. There was a \$1,500 gift for UMCOR disaster relief received during the month and these funds were sent to the conference for expenditure for this purpose. MUMC also received the first wave of building use donations from users of the baseball field during the month.


